Care & Maintenance Tips



Daily Maintenance for Standard Use:

- Mashakpiper leather is naturally resilient and long-lasting.
- Minimal daily care is required, avoiding excessive cleaning.



Preventing Accumulation for Durability:

- Accumulation of dirt and grease over time can be detrimental.
- Regular light cleaning using a damp cloth is recommended.



Cleaning Routine for High Traffic Areas:

- Heavy traffic leather requires a thorough cleaning routine.
- Recommend organizing a plan with a specialized cleaning service.



Avoiding Damage from Dirt and Dust:

- Dirt and dust are abrasive and can damage the protective finish.
- Use a humid cloth for light cleaning; avoid creams, waxes, or polishes.



Helpful Hints and Tips:

- Clean dust with a soft, dry woolen cloth in circular movements.
- Use a mild soap solution for light cleaning; remove dirt promptly.
- Avoid aggressive chemicals; check cleaner compatibility.
- Minimize direct sunlight exposure; handle stains with care.



Seasonal Deep Cleaning:

- Perform deep cleaning twice a year using a specific cleaner and conditioner.
- Apply cleaner with circular movements; let leather dry before re-polishing.
